

Report of the 9th International Update on Neuroanesthesia and Neurointensive Care EURONEURO 2016

The 9th International Update on Neuroanesthesia and Neurointensive Care (EURONEURO 2016) was held in Barcelona, Spain, from April 14–16, 2016. The conference venue was Hotel Barcelo Sants. This three-days scientific extravaganza was attended by over 650 delegates from across the globe. This conglomeration of renowned faculties from all disciplines of neurosciences was a unique event in itself. The scientific programme was well planned and included lectures and workshops ranging from topics related to the basic research in neurosciences, to those related to clinical practice. A special session on Nursing Neurocare was also arranged during the meet. Participants had the opportunity to present their research papers which were judged by a panel of experts. An overwhelming participation was seen by the ISNACC members, with nearly 24 abstracts submitted this year, which is more than that observed in the previous Euroneuro meet.

Some of the topics that were covered in this meeting were Mapping the anatomy of (un)consciousness, Basic Neurosciences, Intraoperative pharmacological brain protection,

Engineering to measure effects: designing new devices and understanding processes, Surgery and Anesthesia at the extreme of ages: consequences for the brain, New brain monitoring perspectives, “Cognitive reserve” and Postoperative Cognitive Dysfunction (POCD), Consciousness, ECC, ECMO, CPR and the brain, Cerebral monitoring at the bedside, Neurophysiology Monitoring in the perioperative setting and critical care, Quantitative MRI in brain injury, Improving outcome in traumatic brain injury, Coagulation, neurosurgery and neuroangioradiology, Decompressive craniectomy, Ventilation strategies in Neurocritical Patients, Update in vascular Neurocritical ischemic patient management, Hot spots in endovascular therapy, New approaches in neurosurgery and chronically neurological diseases, Initial Attention to Neurocritical Patient, Education in Neuroscience Specialists and Rehabilitation after Acute Brain Injury.

The gala dinner at the Sant Pau Art Nouveau Site was an evening to remember. The memories of this beautiful city with the Gaudi architecture and facing the Mediterranean Sea will remain fresh for a very very long time.



Announcements

Travel/ Visit Grant

ISNACC provides Travel/Visit Grant to suitable candidates to either visit one of the premier Neurosciences (Neuroanaesthesiology) Centers abroad or to present scientific paper(s) in an International forum. The last date for submission of application will be July 31 and December 31. A fixed sum of Rs.25,000/- (6 candidates per year) will be awarded to candidates who must fulfill the following criteria -

- Should be a life-member for more than a year at the time of application.
- He/she should not have availed the grant from ISNACC in the previous 2 years.
- Must submit the abstract of the scientific work at the time of application.
- Must submit the attendance and participation/presentation certificate within 15 days of attending the conference

Research Grant

ISNACC awards research grant to suitable candidates to carry out clinical research in the field of Neuroanaesthesia and Neurocritical Care in India. A fixed sum of Rs.50,000/- [2 candidates per year] will be awarded to candidates who fulfill the following criteria –

- Should be a life-member for more than a year at the time of application.
- He/she should not have availed the grant from ISNACC in previous 2 years
- Should provide a copy of Ethics Committee approval and the protocol (both soft and hard copy)
- The candidate must provide the estimated expenditure details along with the application.
- Financial assistance from other sources must be disclosed
- The proposal would be scrutinized by the education committee of ISNACC and its decision would be final.
- Should complete the study within 2 years of obtaining the grant and must produce the statement of expenditure.
- Should present the results of the research in the Annual conference of ISNACC in the same year as completion of study or within one year of completing the study.
- Should acknowledge ISNACC as the funding source in all forms of presentation / publication.
- Last date for submission of application is December 31.






